DUE DATE: April 24, 2009

- NHHSP Application** - Application completed electronically via website: www.nhhsp.org.
- Birth Certificate** (true copy). If your birth certificate does not indicate Hawaiian ancestry, please attach a true copy of a parent whose birth certificate indicates Hawaiian descent with your birth certificate. No photocopies of birth certificate will be accepted and will be considered an invalid document.

Note: Birth certificate(s) will not be returned to the applicant but kept in their application file so it is necessary for all applicants to send a true copy of their birth certificate. True copies of birth certificates can be obtained at the Department of Health for a nominal fee.

Individuals born outside the United States, Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, U.S. Virgin Islands and the Territorial of Guam must submit documentary proof of U.S. citizenship.

- Resume** a minimum of one page and a maximum of two. No personal statements or cover letters will be accepted. Please do not substitute a personal statement in lieu of the required resume.
- Official College Transcripts** of all previous coursework. "Official" is defined as transcripts with the university's embossed seal. Transcripts must be in a sealed envelope and mailed directly from the school to the scholarship program. All transcripts must be addressed to the attention of Lei Arvin, Administrative Assistant. **No student-issued** transcripts will be accepted.

Your supporting documents should not include any student-issued transcripts. All transcripts must come directly from the university to NHHSP.

- Other** (if applicable). Supplemental document/information regarding change of name, social security number, etc. if your legal name is different on any submitted documents.

DUE DATE: June 1, 2009

- College Letter of Acceptance** to an accredited college program of study (for First Year students). Photocopies are acceptable only and no email letters will be considered. All letters must be on University letterhead.
